Entries

Final Entries should be submitted using the Online Entry System that can be found on the address:

<https://www.swimrankings.net/manager/>.

By default technical entry times for an individual and relay events will be based on information from the European Swimming Federation (LEN) rankings database and other FINA members' competition results that are achieved in Open Competition in last fifteen (15) months and can be found on the website: www.swimrankings.net.

Swimmers, who's achieved results from the database mismatch with the results from technical entry, will start with mark 'NT'.

All competing swimmers must be entered in the meet (even if they are not swimming in individual events) and relay entries should be filled with the names of the swimmers respectively (with the only exception of the mix relays in case of the Online Entry System malfunction).

Entry Reports must be sent by the team representative and received by the Swimming Federation of Latvia **till 26th April 2019, 20:00** by e-mail to the address: info@swimming.lv indicating in the e-mail subject the names of the meet and the team.

The entries should be considered received after the sender has got the confirmation e-mail (reply). If the entries have not been sent through the National swimming federation those are considered accepted after receiving the confirmation from the National swimming federation (which should be the FINA member).

The last corrections (substitution) can be made **till 19:59 of 29th April, 2019**.

All names and surnames for all the team representatives must be sent by e-mail together with the Entry Report to the e-mail address: info@swimming.lv.

In case the names of the swimmers of relays should be substituted as from the Entry Reports, the application form for the relays, with the names of the swimmers, must be submitted to the secretary of the competition no later than 45 minutes before the start of the session in which the race takes place.

Withdrawals from the competition or the sessions can be made 45 minutes before the beginning of the subsequent session.

Starting fees

Starting fee of 8,00 EUR for each individual start and 16,00 EUR for each relay start shall be paid by 27/04/2019 using bank transfer. Document of the payment shall be verified at the venue.

Prizes and Medals

Three best swimmers in each age group and at every event and relays will be awarded with medals.

Six best swimmers will be awarded with special prizes. Overall ranking will be calculated according to FINA Long Course Points Table. Overall prize requires personal appearance at the prize ceremonies in the end of the competition.
