The Estonian Aquatic Sports School invites you to the **Nordic Kids Cup in Artistic (Synchronized) Swimming 2021**, which will be held in Tartu, Estonia from December 4th to December 5th, 2021. The competition is held in cooperation with the **Estonian Swimming Federation**.

The aim of the competition is to identify in Nordic countries best club in artistic (synchronized) swimming. Also we want to encourage performance sports events to provide opportunities for performance athletes to compete as well as enhance their mastery, and for the audience as an attractive spectacle, to promote friendship relationships with Northern Europe countries.

COMPETITION INFORMATION

Venue: Aura Water Centre (*est* Aura Veekeskus), 10 Turu Str, Tartu, Estonia, 51013

Pool dimensions: The depth at the lower end of the pool is 1.2 m and at the deeper end 1.85 m. Competition area 25×25 m, depth 1,85 m.

Referee: Natalia Belova (Russia)

Age groups:

- "10 and under" (born in 2011 and younger)
- "12 and under" (born in 2009 and younger)

Each sports organization is allowed to register:

- "10 and under" and „12 and under“ –figures only
- "10 and under" and „12 and under“ – figures and 2 Solos, 2 Duets/Mixed Duets, 1 Team and 1 Combination

Competition events and awards

"10 and under" and „12 and under“:

- Figures: 100%
- Figures: 100% + free routine (Solo, Duet, Mixed Duet, Team): 100%
- Free Combination 100%

Medals will be awarded for 1-3 places. „10 and under“ figures medals will be awarded 2011-2012 and 2013 and younger separately.

The club that has collected the maximum number of prizes according to the results of the competition **will be awarded the competition cup!**

Competition quotas

Clubs from the Nordic countries are invited to participate in the competition: Ireland, Great Britain, Norway, Iceland, Denmark, Sweden, Finland, Faroe Islands, Lithuania, Latvia and Estonia.

Rules:

The competitions are held in accordance with FINA rules 2017-2021

Time limits for the age groups „10 and under“ and “12 and under”: Solo 2:00 min., Duet/Mixed Duet 2:30 min., Team 3:00 min., Combi 3:00 min.

The timing error can be 15 seconds

Each sports organization is required to provide at least 2 judges. In case the organization does not provide judges, the fine is 50 euros per judge.

Mandatory committee will be held in Aura Water Centre (est Aura Veekeskus), 10 Turu Str, Tartu, Estonia, 51013 03.12.2021 12:30 - 20:00 EET.

Draw of Figures:

„12 and under“ figures shall be drawn on 03.12.2021 at 12.00 EET. Result of draw shall be sent to club/federation contact person by email without delay.

„10 and under“ figures will be sent in a separate document along with the invitation and entry form.

Safety

The organizers of the competition guarantee the medical safety service throughout the competition period. **Each participant must have medical insurance for the duration of the competition.**

NB!!! Due to the changing situation with regard to the spread of the COVID-19 virus in different countries, it may change in terms of entering the country and participating in a sports event. In this regard, please follow the information we send you after the registration deadline.

The host party guarantees medals, cups, diplomas. Accommodation, food and transport costs are covered by the participants.

Participation fees

Events: Figures, Solo, Duet, Mixed Duets, Team performance, Combination

1 event – 15 €

2 events – 25 €

3 events – 35 €

4 and more events – 45 €

Competitor can take part in both figures sessions ("10 and under" and "12 and under") if he meets the age criteria. In this case, the payment is calculated from participation in two events (Figures + Figures = 25 euros).

In the Free Routines competitor has the right to compete in only one age category.

Pre-registration: November 05th 2021.



Registration deadline: November 19th 2021.

After registration, invoices will be issued within three days, which are payable by **November 26th 2021.**

Music

For the performance, the music must be on a good quality CD or USB media with the name of the performance and the artist.

The music files must be submitted electronically via the Internet in mp3 format *Fina Rule AS15.3 Method 2.

Each performance must be named "event_program_name of the competitors/team_name of the club_national federation.mp3".

For example:

12andunder_team_EVK_EestiVeespordialadeKool_EST.mp3

or

10andunder_duet_Domoskanova_Fedoruk_EestiVeespordialadeKool_EST.mp3

The audio files must be sent to competition@evk.edu.ee no later than **November 19th, 2021.**
